The Hickory Hills Park District, Cook County, Illinois, is requesting statements of interest, qualifications and performance data (“RFQ”) from qualified architectural firms with respect to the renovation of Memorial Park, Prairie View Park and various alternates for other park sites, including replacement of drinking fountains and seating areas and shade. The services of the architect shall be performed in cooperation with the Park District.

A proposal pre-submission meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 1, 2018 at the Cynthia Neal Center, 8047 W. 91<sup>st</sup> Place, Hickory Hills, IL for the purpose of providing a summary of available information on the current parks. No e-mail or fax submittals will be accepted.

The firm(s) selected must comply with applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and executive orders including but not limited to those pertaining to equal employment opportunity.

The selection of the successful firm for the project shall be at the District’s discretion and shall be made pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Professional Services Selection Act, 50 ILCS 510/0.01, *et seq.* The District reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, or to accept any portion of the proposal, to waive any formality, technicality or irregularity in any proposal, and to be the sole judge of the value and merit of the proposals offered. Such decisions by the District shall be final.
